




| Some interventions of MOT


- European Territorial Cooperation Operational programs 2007-2013:

- Study of a « Maison Transfrontalière » (cross border information center) France (Guyane)-Brésil (for Chambre of Commerce of Guyane)

From government to flexible multi-level governance


Old fixed action space

Improving the strategic dimension of cooperation

- Need of ***strategies for “cross-border regions”***
- States **coordinating data, legislation, financing and institutions, across borders**; with the support of the EU
- All EU funded Operational Programs, and national/regional programs, can contribute to Territorial Cooperation; ETC (Interreg) =catalyst.

What is true for EU “macro-regions” also applies to cross border cooperation.


Territorial Cooperation: flagship instrument of **“territorial cohesion” and integration**: should be at the core of EU and national strategies.




Key ideas for Smart Cooperation
